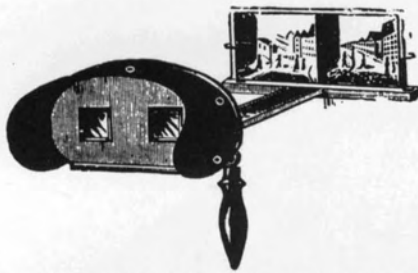

- 1S1 Switzerland-A lovely glass view by G. Papot of a valley; mountains in the background, w/a resort building in the foreground. Horse & carriage in front. V.G.C., \$11 plus \$1 Ship.
- 1S2 Panoramic view of Naples (Italy) & Vesuvius. An interesting glass view in V.G. Cond., \$11 plus \$1 Ship.
- 1S3 "Mauch Chuck Railroad" -2 orange mt. views; (1) "Mauch Chuck from Mountain Road." (great train view) & (2) "Mt. Pisah Flume 864 ft. high--; (also of train)". In G./V.G.C., \$7PP for pair.
- 1S4 Railroad-"668 Interior of Snow Shed, Summit Station Sierra Nevada Mountains, C.P.R.R.". An orange mt. view by Pond of Buffalo, N.Y. Head-on view of wood-burning locomotive in shed. In G. Cond., \$6 PP.
- 1S5 Locomotive on Niagara Suspension Bridge. A cream mt. by George Barker, c.1890. Nice head-on view of the locomotive. VGC \$6PP.
- 1S6 Elmer & Tenney Minnesota Snow Views Series of 1881. No.'s 1192, 1195 & 1202 (3 views) taken on the Winona & St. Peter Div., C & N.W.R.R. Cream imperial mts. of blocks of snow being removed & trains going through the cut. Wood-burning locomotives in two views & work train in other. G./V.G. Cond., \$18 PP/lot.
- 1S7 Another---Green mt. taken on Southern Minnesota Div., C.M & St. P. R'y. No. 1135. Men pose on large block of snow; ready to be hauled out of cut. In V.G. Cond., \$6 PP.
- 1S8 Coal Mining-Three orange mt. views by Gates of Syracuse; (1) Coal shaft (outside view). (2) View at Antrim (Pa.) Coal Fields-Steam locomotive pulls 6 coal-loaded cars, & (3) "Coming out of Mines Antrim, Pa."-Miners pose behind horse-drawn mine cars. All in G. Cond., \$12 PP for the lot.
- 1S9 "H.M.S. "Cambridge"-Great Guns Practice". A green mt. close-up of this man-of-war in action. In G. Cond., \$6 PP.
- 1S10 Men-of-War. La Harve, France. Two military sailing ships w/ "steam tug towing vessels going out of port". V.G.C., \$6 PP.
- 1S11 "Stereograph Record, William McKinley, Beloved by all the People". A set, in carton of tan mt's, U. & U. curved cards plus two others. (A total of 14). G./V.G. Cond., \$40 PP.
- 1S12 "Train-Load of 1st Bengal Lancers' Horses in Open Cars arrive at Station, Tientsin, China." 1901, R. U. & U. tan curved mt. card in V.G. Cond., \$4 PP.
- 1S13 Another---"President McKinley leaving the Church after addressing the Grand Army, Pacific Grove, Cal.". V.G. Cond., \$3 PP.

- 1S15 Another---"All aboard from Pike's Peak, Col." A close-up view of the locomotive & passenger car. In G. Cond., \$3 PP.
- 1S16 Stereoscopic content-Library-study w/Becker's viewer in background. Gas lighting. V.G. Cond., \$6 PP.
- 1S17 Photographic-Camera on tripod & photographer's wagon, "No. 442, Tunnel No. 3, Upper Weber Canyon, Union Pacific Rail Road". In G. Cond., \$8 PP.

- 1S26 Leaning Tower of Pisa, Italy. A nice U. & U. gray mt. view in V.G. Cond., \$2 PP.
- 1S27 Emigrants in Steerage. A view reminiscent of Stieglitz', "The Steerage". Information on orange mt. card in Norwegian (we think) although published in Chicago. G. Cond., some chipping of mt., \$4 PP.
- 1S28 "32268T, General View of Decorating Shop in a Large Pottery Plant, Trenton, N.J." (probably Lenox). A gray curved mt. by Keystone. In Exc. Cond., \$3 PP.
- 1S29 Gurnsey's Rocky Mountain Views-Two cream mt. scenics. (1) Mineral Springs & (2) The Idiot Monument. In G/F Cond., \$5 PP for the pair.
- 1S30 "No. 1142 Mount Watkins and Old Chief". A western scenic by Bierstadt in G. Cond., \$2 PP.
- 1S31 Gurnsey's Rocky Mountain Views-A set of 3 yellow imperial mt. views. (1) No. 25, "The Ute's Medicinal Monument", (2) No. 36 "Natural Monuments in Monument Park." & (3) No. 155, "Templeton's Gap, "Mother Gurdy". All in V.G. Cond., \$12PP for the lot.
- 1S32 W.G. Chamberlain, Denver, Col. A green mt. view of the Garden of the Gods, El Mayordorno Rock. In V.G. Cond., \$5 PP.
- 1S33 Collier's Rocky Mountain Scenery, No. 38, "Boulder Series, Mill on South Boulder, "yellow mt. in G. Cond., \$6 PP.
- 1S34 Northern Pacific/Yellowstone Park Scenery by Haynes, St. Paul, Minn. A set of 12 views on tan mts. A very nice series of western scenics. Would be considered Exc. Cond., except 6 cards have corner slightly chewed from display in Beckers viewer. The lot, \$20 PP for the lot.
- 1S35 Yosemite-Five yellow imperial mt. cards by Anthony. No's. 10, 45, 65, 74 & 90. Grillwork "moresque" backs, c.1873. All in G. Cond., \$30 PP.
- 1S36 Watkins Pacific Coast-Yellow mt. view, #1881 U.S.S. Kearsage, Mare Island". A steam-powered warship. G.C., \$10 PP.
- 1S37 "W.H. Jackson, Photographer to the U.S. Survey of the Territories" - "Natural Bridge in San Sante (?) Canon". Men pose in front. In G. Cond., \$10 PP.
- 1S38 Anthony-Two yellow mt. views of the Catskills; No. 417, "Catskill Mt. House" & No. 4198, "Haines Gorge (waterfall)" Revenue stamp on verso. G. Cond., \$8 PP for the pair.
- 1S39 Cornell University. A yellow mt. view by Gates of South Building. Students in front. In G. Cond., \$4 PP.
- 1S40 Fat Lady-"Miss Belmont". A cream curved mt. by Ingersol of St. Paul, Minn. Formally-dressed ample gal. V.G.C., \$5 PP.
- 1S41 Full Moon. A U & U. tan curved mt. by Bierstadt from Prof. Draper's negatives. In V.G. Cond., \$3 PP.
- 1S42 Chicago Fire, 1871. An orange-mt. Lovejoy & Foster view, "Water Works in distance". A view of the burned-out structure. In G. Cond., \$5 PP.
- 1S43 Mill River Valley Flood, 1874. A set of 5 green (one yellow) mt. views by Knowlton Bros., Northampton, Mass; of the destruction & wreckage. No's. 46, 57, 58, 73 & 95. In G. Cond., \$15 PP for the lot.
- 1S44 Drug Store-C.B. Smith & Bell. Orange mt. unidentified view of storefront w/the pharmacists & clerks posed in front. In G. Cond., \$4 PP.
- 1S45 Tombs Prison, New York City-2 orange mt. views by Pach. One of the prison yard (w/4 prisoners) & the other of the exterior. G/F Cond., \$5 PP for the pair.
